\$2.2 MILLION IN CAPITAL EXPENDITURE GRANTS FOR SCHOOLS IN FLINDERS

Two local schools will receive grants for their building projects under the Australian Government's Capital Grants Programme. The recipients are:

- ✓ Pearcedale Primary School, \$1,000,000
- ✓ **Dromana** Secondary College, \$1,200,000

\$28.5 MILLION IN ROADS FUNDING FOR ROADS IN FLINDERS

Greg recently announced that the Federal Government has provided \$28.5 Million in Financial Assistance Grants to local Councils primarily to help with roads:



CLOSE THE GUNNAMATTA OCEAN OUTFALL NOW!

Greg, Martin Dixon, and the Clean Ocean Foundation, have continued to call on the Bracks Government to **close** the **Gunnamatta Ocean Outfall** now.

The ocean outfalls at Gunnamatta Beach and Werribee pump 350 billion litres of partially treated sewerage into our beaches every year. "This is an astonishing amount of sewerage being pumped just off our beaches, but what is far more concerning, is that the sewerage is being pumped just metres away from surfers", Greg said.

This has a detrimental effect on the health of locals and surfers, the local environment and is a waste of water that could be recycled.

LPG REBATE FOR FAMILIES IN FLINDERS

As part of the Howard Government's response to high world petrol prices, a new grant is being provided to assist people who want to convert their cars to LPG. Grants are available from 14 August 2006 and the details are as follows:

- A grant of \$2,000 will be available to purchasers of an approved and fitted LPG conversion of a private vehicle:
- A grant of \$1,000 to purchasers of a private factory fitted LPG vehicle; and
- Application and guidelines can be lodged at Centrelink or Medicare Offices from 1 October 2006, in person or by post.
