# SUCCESS IN FUNDING BATTLE FOR ST MARY'S CHILD CARE SERVICE, HASTINGS

Earlier this year Rosemary Hallowell from St Mary's Child Care Service in **Hastings** contacted Greg to advise that St Mary's would not be receiving funding for their child care places in the 2006-07 financial year.

As soon as Greg heard that the service was in danger of being lost to families in Hastings, he:

- ✔ Wrote to the Minister for Families and Community Services;
- ✓ Met with the Minister's office;
- Helped organise a financial review; and
- ✓ Met with the Minister and argued the Case for funding.

Following this action, the Minister has now re-instated St Mary's Federal Government funding—as such, this service will continue to operate for local families. Greg congratulated the committee and Rosemary on their hard work and commitment to ensuring that the community did not lose this vital service.
