HUNT ANNOUNCES \$100,000 FOR PHILLIP ISLAND NATURE PARK

Phillip Island Nature Park will receive an Australian Government grant of \$100,000 for their 'Enhancing the Phillip Island Koala Conservation Centre Visitor Experience' project to promote ecotourism on Phillip Island.

\$97,420 GRANT FOR WARLEY HOSPITAL

I am delighted to announce that Warley Hospital, **Phillip Island**, will receive a further \$97,420 from the Australian Government's \$36 million *Rural Private Access Program*.

This funding will help develop a 10 year plan for the hospital's long term future.

This is on top of the existing \$1.3 million annually given to Warley by the Australian Government for aged care beds. In addition, the Australian Government has pledged a further \$1.5 million annually for 40 new aged care places at Warley.

GREG OPENS NEW CLASSROOMS AT ST JOHN THE BAPTIST KOO WEE RUP

Greg recently opened the new classrooms and administration area at St John the Baptist Primary School, **Koo Wee Rup**.

The project was jointly funded by the Australian Government (\$475,000) and the local community (\$160,000).
