Gunnamatta outfall closure a welcome step closer

am working with Greg Hunt to close the outfall at Gunnamatta Beach. Greg is relentless on this issue. Thanks to Greg we are now moving significantly closer to closing the Gunnamatta outfall with the Victorian Opposition committing to close the Gunnamatta outfall by 2015 and all of Victoria's ocean outfalls by 2025.

As a member of the Agriculture, Fisheries, Forestry and Conservation

Committee, I commend this policy and I share Greg's vision for a national ocean outfall closure strategy to close both the pipe at Gunnamatta Beach along with all of Australia's 142 ocean outfalls.

Not only are ocean outfalls a massive waste of water but the marine environment and coastline near the outfalls are being irrevocably damaged. In the next 10 years the true financial cost both in water lost and damage done is estimated to be about \$2 billion.

I am working with Greg and local State Member Martin Dixon MLA on a proposal to improve the treatment of water currently being dumped at Gunnamatta Beach and to make it available to local farmers and industries on the Peninsula and around Western Port as well as for industries in the Latrobe Valley where large power generators are located.

If we can use the treated water currently discharged at Gunnamatta Beach in industry and agriculture then it will lead to a cleaner and safer marine environment as well as help reduce pressure on our river systems by significantly freeing up natural water flows for the Gippsland Lakes which are suffering severe environmental strain.
