

REVITALISING THE HASTINGS RAILWAY STATION

Hastings railway station provides a first impression to many visitors to the area and unfortunately that impression is no longer the thriving and endearing symbol it used to be.

However, the railway station has great potential. Located right in the heart of Hastings, it is surrounded by approximately 3 hectares of vacant land that is owned by the railway company. With a little vision and hard work I believe that it can be turned into a wonderful community asset such as perhaps a park, public market or nursery/market garden for primary and secondary students.

That is why I am working with Connex through the Stationeers Program to transfer the management of the station and surrounding land to the community. This will help revitalise the community and I am interested in your ideas. In particular, there is also space for any new buildings such as a Community Health Centre.

TWO NEW DOCTORS FOR SOMERVILLE

I am pleased to announce the extension of the Outer Metropolitan Doctors incentive program to 30 June 2006, and to welcome two new doctors to **Somerville** who will benefit from the scheme.

Already the extension to the Outer Metropolitan Doctors incentive program has helped to encourage two new doctors to Somerville's Eramosa Family Medical Centre which is now able to offer increased hours.

We have already had new doctors come to the Peninsula under the Scheme and others are currently making enquiries about moving to areas such as Pearcedale, Flinders and Cranbourne as well.

NEW MEDICARE CENTRE FOR CRANBOURNE

I am delighted to announce that the new Medicare office for Cranbourne will open within the next few months.

Elderly residents, along with young families throughout **Cranbourne**, **Devon Meadows**, **Clyde**, **Junction Village** and the **Coastal Villages** will now be able to conveniently access Medicare services in Cranbourne. This is a fantastic outcome for the local community.

MORE FUNDING FOR PEARCEDALE PRIMARY

Students and staff at **Pearcedale Primary** will benefit from \$650,000 in Federal funding for new buildings and facilities.

The funding will help with the construction of general purpose classrooms, a library and deaf facilities.

These new facilities will greatly assist the school to provide the best possible learning environment for students in Pearcedale and the surrounding region. I congratulate the school and staff for all their wonderful work and dedication.
