\$26 million to tackle childhood heart disease

Congenital heart disease is the leading cause of deaths for Australian infants and the second leading cause of death for children.

The Coalition Government will establish the HeartKids Project with \$26 million to tackle childhood heart disease, which affects more than 65,000 Australians.

This funding from the Medical Research Future Fund will support our best and brightest researchers to translate their vital work into real health benefits – better diagnosis, treatment and prevention of congenital heart disease.

\$10.6 billion in lifesaving medicines listed on the Pharmaceutical benefits Scheme

Since 2013, the Coalition Government has listed more than 2,000 new or amended items on the PBS.

This represents an average of around 30 listings per month – or one each day – at an overall cost of around \$10.6 billion.

This has taken medication that would have cost patients up to \$250,000,

to as little as \$6.40 per script for concession patients.

This includes medication for conditions such as cystic fibrosis, leukaemia, and several types of cancer.

Our commitment to the PBS is rock solid. Together with Medicare, it is a foundation of our world-class health care system.

\$150,000 for Stronger Communities

Community groups around the electorate are benefitting from \$150,000 in grants thanks to the Federal Government's Stronger Communities Programme.

The grants will fund projects that will deliver social benefits to a variety of groups by supporting participation and contributing to our local community.

Successful projects include:

- New Peninsula Men's Shed - \$15,000 for new shed facilities in **Mount Martha**
- **Sorrento** Sea Scouts - \$11,000 to repaint and restore the interior and exterior of their scout hall.
- Fusion Australia - \$8,000 to assist local youths suffering from homelessness
- U3A **Hastings** - \$3,700 for new computers and computer literacy programmes in Western Port.
- **Red Hill** Agricultural & Horticultural Society - \$3,500 to renovate Scott House for the local community.
- **Point Leo** Lifesaving Club - \$8,000 to improve community access and security at the clubhouse.
- **French Island** Community Association - \$4,000 to repair and restore community tennis courts.
- **Mount Martha** Lifesaving Club - \$6,000 for the Club's 'Fountains for Change' program.
- **Blaigowrie** Community Garden - \$2,500 to improve water conservation.

- **Tyabb** Scout Group - \$16,000 to refurbish hall, kitchen and toilet facilities at the Tyabb Scout Hall.
- **Somerville** Eagles Soccer Club - \$2,500 for portable lights for their women's, men's and junior teams.
- **Dromana** Bowls Club - \$2,500 to improve disabled access to the club and carpark
- **Rye** Community House - \$12,500 to upgrade external areas, including play area, community herb garden and active ageing equipment.
- **Southern Peninsula** Community Support and Information Centre - \$12,500 for new office spaces at their **Rosebud** centre
- Peninsula Ballet Ensemble - \$4,500 to update dance studio facilities in **Somerville**
- Salvation Army Westernport Mission Centre - \$2,800 for new fridge and food preparation facilities in **Hastings**.

Support for People with Type 1 Diabetes

Free access to glucose monitoring devices will save pregnant women, children and more adults living with type 1 diabetes up to \$7,000 a year from the start of March, thanks to an investment by the Coalition Government into the through the expansion of the Continuous Glucose Monitoring (CGM) Initiative.

From March, eligibility for fully subsidised CGM products was expanded to include:

- children and young people with conditions very similar to type 1 diabetes, such as cystic fibrosis related diabetes and neonatal diabetes, who require insulin;
- women with type 1 diabetes who are pregnant, actively planning pregnancy, or immediately post-pregnancy; and
- people with type 1 diabetes aged 21 years or older who have concessional status and have a high clinical need to access CGM products.

Increasing access to CGM products will help more people with type 1 diabetes manage this difficult disease better, as well as further support their families and carers.

\$3 million for headspace and youth mental health services on the Mornington Peninsula

\$5 million secured for the Rosebud Aquatic Centre

Investing \$3.5 billion in the Climate Solutions Package

Like most people in our community, I support action on climate change, a stronger economy and lower energy prices.

We have an obligation to protect our environment for future generations. We must also ensure a strong economy, so the next generation can find jobs.

The Morrison Government has recently announced the \$3.5 billion Climate Solutions Package.

As part of this package, local groups will be able to apply for a range of Federal Government Grants, including:

- Up to \$12,500 in grants for community groups to install solar photovoltaic, solar hot water and battery systems under the Solar Communities Grants;
- Eligible small businesses will be able to apply for grants of up to \$25,000 to assist them to become more energy efficient;
- Grants of between \$2,500 and \$20,000 for local environmental projects under the Communities Environment Program.
